Tournament Rules: Scoring and prizes: **A) All participants must sign a release of liability agreement before the tournament starts;** forms must be on shore and proof of release given to the port captain before weigh-in is official or **the boat is disqualified** from that event.
B) Weigh in is one person's legal limit out of port fishing.
C) The boat captain is to sign the weigh-in sheet.
D) One (1) point per pound and 5 points per fish will be used when tabulating each boats score. (Tournament participants must be in line by 2:00 pm for weigh in with fish and one crew person, initial and write in time on weight in sheet, unless approval for tardiness is given by the port chairman, or his designee (boat problems etc.). There will be five (5) points deducted from total score when late and every fifteen (15) minutes after that, up to forty-five (45) minutes. After forty-five (45) minutes you will be disqualified.
